**When you arrive**  
You will be given PPE to wear



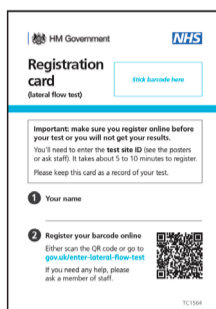

**You will be asked**  
To consent to testing and if you have any symptoms

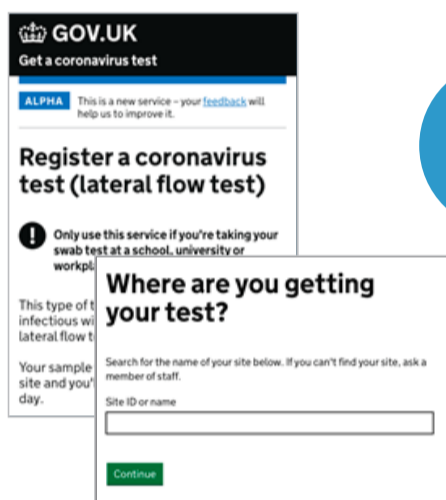
**You will be given**  
A registration card and 4 copies of your unique barcode



1 barcode for your registration card  
1 barcode for your test device  
2 spares

**You will be asked**  
To register your test kit online at:  
[gov.uk/enter-lateral-flow-test](https://gov.uk/enter-lateral-flow-test)



This is to link your test sample and to receive your results later.

You will need to enter:

- The individual barcode
- The test site ID – (we will give you the ID)
- Personal information (including date of birth)
- Your contact details
- Time and date of test

Ask for help if you are unsure about how to go online or to enter your details

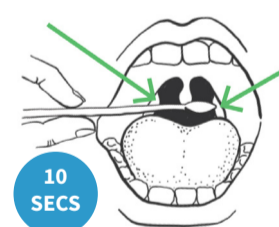
**You can now**  
Move through to the swabbing area  
Hand one of your barcodes to your tester

**Now it's time for you to**  
Self swab

Un-package the swab and self administer the swab sample for both your throat and nose as shown



When complete hand the swab to your tester (*be careful not to touch the end of the swab*)

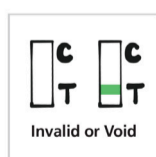
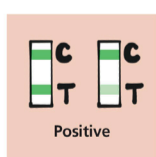
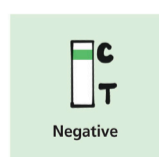
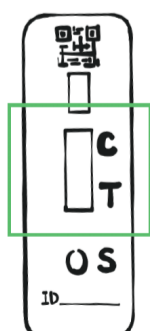

You will need to wait for 20 to 30 minutes

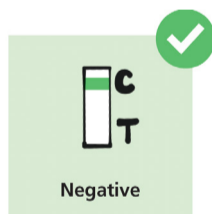


## Understanding the results

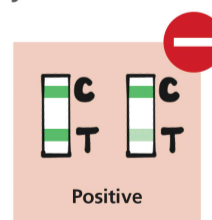
The results are interpreted by examining the presence of coloured lines on the test device



Positive results can be reported at 20 minutes. Negative results can be reported after 30 minutes.



**Negative result**  
You can now begin your visit.



**Positive result**  
You can no longer proceed with your visit. You will be asked to take a PCR test on site and then return home safely to isolate immediately.
